MINUTES

The September 3, 2024 regular meeting of the Health and Human Services Committee was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Vice-Chairperson Mulder.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given by all.

Commissioner Brehler moved to approve the September 3, 2024, agenda. Commissioner Rogers seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Brehler moved to approve the August 5, 2024 minutes as presented. Commissioner Rogers seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Limited Public Comment. None.

Amy Dolinky, Technical Adviser for the Michigan Association of Counties (MAC), presented the Community Assessment Recommendations that will be part of the Eaton County Substance Use and Misuse Strategic Plan. She explained the difference between Tier 1 and Tier 2 recommendations. Discussion was held.

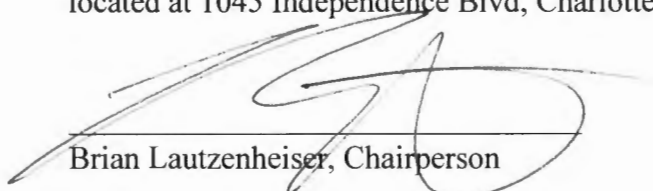
Commissioner Brehler moved to recommend approval of a Resolution to Adopt the Substance Use and Misuse Strategic Plan and Community Assessment Recommendations to the Board of Commissioners. Commissioner Mudry seconded. Motion carried unanimously. This resolution also establishes an Opioid Settlement Oversight Committee. Commissioner Mulder stated he would like the members of the committee to serve a three-year term. Discussion was held. The Opioid Fund currently has a balance of \$2.2 million. The tentative recommended yearly spending for the committee is \$300,000 to \$400,000 per year.
