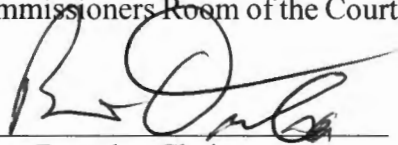
Director of Technology Services, Eric Daley, presented the department's monthly report. Director Daley announced that Jon Merrick has been selected to be a part of Michigan's newly established GIS advisory board. Information in reference to the circumstances around the power outage the courthouse experienced was discussed and an update was given on the Delta substation project. Discussion was also held in reference to the Barry Eaton Health Department transitioning to managing some of their own technology such as voicemail and portable work staff. Additionally, Mr. Daley stated the State of Michigan has a no cost docket display solution that will probably start at the beginning of next year. On February 6, 2025 the Circuit Court case management system will transition to a new system run by the State of Michigan. Depending on the success of that program the District Courts will transfer over in June of 2025. This program has been in the works for over two years.
