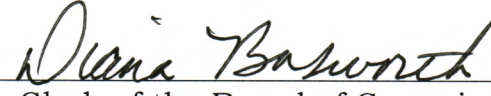
Public Comment: County resident Jim Billig spoke regarding his county drain assessment.
