None.

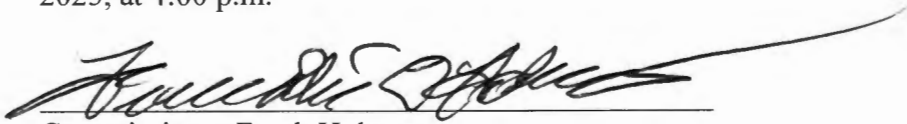
LIMITED PUBLIC COMMENT
