MINUTES

The November 6, 2025, regular meeting of the Public Safety Committee was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Vice-Chairperson Holmes.

The Pledge of Allegiance was given by all.

AGENDA ADDITIONS AND CHANGES

Commissioner Toomey moved to approve the agenda as presented. Commissioner Haskell seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Haskell moved to approve the October 2, 2025, meeting minutes as presented. Commissioner Peek seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

LIMITED PUBLIC COMMENT

Dan McLane, Northville, MI., represented the towing services calling for further review of the Wrecker Policy, citing inefficiency and a lack of fairness.

SHERIFF'S OFFICE UPDATE

Sheriff Reich reported the highlights for the month of October 2025. Court Security Deputy Hafner presented an overview of the Court Security Process and average monthly statistics for the courthouse and Youth Facility.

WRAP PROGRAM UPDATE

Corrections Captain Aaron Kayne reported on the finalization of the state-funded Western Regional Alternative Prison (WRAP) Program due to the funding being eliminated in the State budget. Undersheriff Cook also provided information regarding the funding elimination.

DELTA TOWNSHIP FIRE ALERT SYSTEM INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT

HR Director/Deputy Administrator Ben Dawson provided information regarding the Agreement. Kelly Flynn, Central Dispatch Director, provided additional information. Commissioner Haskell moved to recommend approval of the Agreement to the Ways and Means Committee. Commissioner Peek seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT

Undersheriff Cook explained the changes made to the document after the November meeting. The Mutual Aid Agreement is basically three agreements in one document: Mutual Aid Agreement (1), Nashville Mutual Aid Agreement (2), and the Major Crimes Task Force Agreement (3). Undersheriff Cook provided information regarding the definition of each agreement and the duties included. Discussion held. Commissioner Arndt moved to recommend approval of the Mutual Aid Agreement and the Major Crimes Task Force Agreement to the full board. Commissioner Haskell seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Haskell moved to recommend approval of the Nashville Mutual Aid Agreement to the Board of Commissioners for approval pending completed legal review. Discussion held. Commissioner Arndt seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

CENTRAL DISPATCH UPDATE

Kelly Flynn, Central Dispatch Director, presented the monthly department report.

WRECKER POLICY

Discussion was held on the status of the draft Wrecker Policy. Research and review of the policy and fee schedule continues.

EMERGENCY SERVICES UPDATE

Ryan Wilkinson, Emergency Services Manager, presented the monthly department report. It was noted that planning has started on the Statewide Exercise scheduled for February 2026.

TRIAL COURTS COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS ADVISORY BOARD (CCAB) APPOINTMENT

Commissioner Toomey moved to recommend the appointment of Rebekah Condon to the CCAB to serve as a representative in the following areas: mental health, public health, substance abuse, employment and training, or community alternative programs to the Board of Commissioners. Commissioners Haskell seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE

Chief Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Anderson reported case load statistics for the month of October 2025. It was noted a Prosecuting Attorney has been hired and will start on December 1, 2025. It was also reported that grant funds have been approved for a victim engagement portal within the Prosecutor's Office for a two-year time frame.

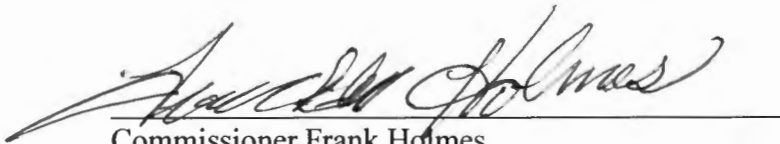
